Impacts of Not Recycling



Why Recycle?

When you don't recycle properly all waste materials end up at the local dump!



What can be recycled? (Blue)

- Milk carton
- Juice carton
- Paper




What is organics? (Green)

- Napkins
- Paper boats
- Any leftover food



What is trash? (Black)

- Chip bags
- Juice lid
- Plastic forks and spoons



Game

“You will be recycling at lunch, so we are going to practice with a game.”

1. Divide class into groups (about 5 per group)
2. Each group will get an envelope of objects
3. They will have to sort the objects into the correct groups
4. We will check their accuracy and the group done first, WINS!

For Larger Groups ...

1. Divide class in half
2. Hold up an item and have one student go place it in the correct bin
3. Have the rest of the team guide them with a thumbs up and thumbs down to determine the correct bin
